

PPP Moot Code of Conduct

As with the other places where we gather with our PPP community, we do have some expectations, and we want to take a minute to share those with you.

1. Please treat everyone with respect, regardless of race, ethnicity, nationality, gender or gender identity, religion, sexual orientation, age, political affiliation, body type, disability, etc. Harassment and/or discrimination will not be tolerated. In-person guests: this includes unofficial, off-site activities. If you harass a speaker, host, team member (including hotel staff) or other guests, you may be asked to leave.
2. Please do your part to keep this moot family-friendly: do not use profane, obscene, or vulgar language. (One exception: in order to accommodate music choices, the karaoke event is not required to be family friendly.)
3. Please do not discuss, argue, debate, or post about contemporary politics.
4. Please respect the intellectual property rights of others by not sharing any copyrighted content; post only content that you have a right to post.
5. Please do not promote any commercial product or service; the sponsors of our moot have contributed to our event for that privilege, and we ask you to respect their investment.

While we will be monitoring the chats as best we can, you are encouraged to tag or privately message a team member immediately if you encounter any harassment, discrimination, bullying, or hateful language.
